Reading the Winds

"He makes the clouds his chariot and rides on the wings of the wind. He makes winds his messengers." **Psalm 104:3b-4a**

Rhonda and I were recently blessed to be a part of an amazing sailing adventure, sort of a combination marriage retreat and vacation. I know almost nothing about sailing but what I did observe was that one, you need wind and second, you need the skills to work the ropes and sails to harness the wind properly. To be onboard a sailboat with nothing but the wind driving you is quite an exhilarating experience.

Wind is somewhat mysterious; Jesus once when speaking to Nicodemus to explain the new birth, compared the effects of the new birth to the wind (Jn. 3:8). When someone is born again, a new wind of change, the Holy Spirit begins to blow through their life, you can see it (2 Cor. 5:17). Because of the work of God's Spirit, you can point to the "winds of change" in your life as well as sense and see God's work in the world and in His church. In a way, you have become attuned to reading the winds.

I'm incredibly grateful for the fellowship we call Carrollwood Baptist Church. And I see God's Spirit at work in you and in our community, and I hope you too see the gentle winds blowing. Our nursery is growing, new people are regularly visiting with us, there's a great spirit in our meetings, people are stepping up and taking on ministries and helping around the church, people are hungry to follow Jesus, and lives are being changed! A breeze is blowing, now we must all together work the ropes and sails to harness the wind. Will you join your fellow travelers on deck?

There was one time on our sailing adventure that the captain, Drew asked me to help him on deck with a particular rope. We were taking down a sail and the wind was quite strong. I was unsure of what to do, it was a little scary, I thought I might fall overboard at one point, and I had to pull very hard to give him any rope at all, but it was enough, and the sail was brought in. And I did not fall overboard.

It can be a little intimidating making a call to someone in need, or serving a Sunday in the nursery, or being a part of small group, or leading a class for newer believers, or signing up for a commitment to participate in a ministry. You might feel unsure and a little fearful, but God who called you is faithful, and he will supply the grace, wisdom, and strength to pull your rope. And you won't fall overboard.

Henry Blackaby taught us years ago that we do not have to create opportunities for serving, for loving, for impacting people with the gospel, they are already there. We just need to look where God is already at work and join him. Blackaby was essentially saying, "look for the winds, look for God's messengers, they are all around, what are they telling you? Will you pull a rope? Will you set the sail?" In this season of ministry, where winds are blowing and all hands are needed on deck, would you pray and make yourself available to serve, to pull a rope?

But don't limit what's possible by only seeing the needs of your church, God is at work in your family, among your friends, in your neighborhood, and at your business or place of employment. Read the winds right where you are. Together, let's pull our God-appointed ropes, unfurl the sails, and harness the wind. And when we do, it will be exhilarating because it will be God's doing!
